This Indenture made this Ninth Day of February one thousand
hundred fifty nine Between Arthur Arrington junr of the County of
Edgecombe & Province of North Carolina and Mary his wife of the
County of Southampton in Virginia of the
other part Witnesseth that the said Arthur Arrington and Mary
his wife for and in consideration of the sum of sixty two pounds current
money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said John Adams the
Receipt whereof the said Arthur Arrington & Mary his wife doth
hereby acknowledge they the said Arthur Arrington and Mary his
wife hath granted bargained and sold aliened & confirmed and by these presents
doth grant bargain and sell alien and confirm unto the said John
Adams one certain tract or Parcel of land lying and being in the
aforesaid County of Southampton containing one hundred & eighty
acres be the same more or less and Bounded as followeth Beginning
at the mouth of a small branch running between the said land and
Plantation and the old plantation then running up the said branch
to the fork then east to James Chappels line then along the said Chap-
pels line to a pine a corner of Thomas Chappels land then along the
said Thomas Chappels line to a gum in Cowherd Swamp then up
the said Swamp to the Beginning with the divisions and divisions
remaind and remainders rents and services of the said premises and
every part thereof and also all the estate right title Interest claim
and demand whatsoever of them the said Arthur Arrington and Mary
his wife of in and to the said premises and every part thereof
To have and to hold all and singular the said premises within men-
tioned and every part and Parcel thereof with the appurtenances unto
the said John Adams his heirs & assigns to the only proper use & behoof of the said
