Ten pounds current money of Virginia to him in hand paid
by the said John Kirby Junr at or before the executing & delivering
of these presents the receipt whereof he the said William Kirby
doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained sold aliened
and confirmed & by these presents do grant bargain sold aliened
& confirm unto the said John Kirby and to his heirs & assigns
forever a certain parcel of land situate lying and being in the
County and parish aforesaid and on the south side of Netoway
river and on the said side of Cockes swamp and bounded as fol
loweth (to wit) Beginning at a white oak on the south side of the
said Cockes swamp then down the meandering courses of the said
swamp to a white oak a corner tree of Hobbs line thence along
a line of marked trees to a pine a line tree of Taylors thence along
