Benjamin Bailey his executors or assigns the said just and full sum of fifteen pounds seven shillings & eight pence current Money of Virginia with Interest together with the expence of preparing & recording this present Indenture, and upon the aforesd. first day of November next ensuing ^{without} any abatement or deduction as aforesd. according to the true intent & meaning of these presents
