This Indenture made this tenth Day of August in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and sixty eight Between William Glover of the Parish of Nettonay in the County of Southampton of the one part and William Harrison of the County of Essex of the one part and George Thomas White of the County of Surrey of the other part. Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and eighty five pounds current Money of Virginia to the said William Glover in hand paid by the said William Harrison and George Thomas White the receipt whereof the said William Harrison and George Thomas White their heirs executors and administrators have granted Bargained sold aliened released and confirmed and by these presents do grant Bargain sell alien release and confirm unto the said William Harrison and George Thomas White their heirs and assigns one certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the said County of Southampton on Blackwater River Containing three hundred and seventy one Acres and Bounded as followeth Beginning at a gum on the river branch thence thence south eighty one Degrees East one hundred and fourteen poles to a pine thence south sixty degrees East sixty Nine poles to a pine thence South twenty four degrees East twelve poles to a small hickory thence north two degrees West thirty six poles to a small red oak thence north thirty two degrees West to a red oak thence along Margery Whitneys Line to black water River thence down the Meanders of the said River to upper side of Cloures Island thence along the upper side of the said Island to the mouth of the river branch and thence up the Meanders of the S^d Branch to the beginning which said Tract of Land the said William Glover purchased of the executors of William Baynes Deceased by Indenture of bargain and sale bearing date Day of 1768

And the reversion and reversions remainder & remainders with Issues and profits thereof and also all the whole right title and Interest of him the said William Glover his heirs and assigns of in or to the said Tract or parcel of Land and every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said three hundred & seventy one Acres of Land and premises with the appurtenances unto the said William Harrison and George Thomas White their heirs
