This Indenture made this eighth day November in the year
of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & sixty nine Between
Benjamin Williamson of Hertford County, and Arthur Williamson
of Southampton County In Virginia Witnesseth that the said Benjamin
Williamson for and in consideration of two hundred pounds current
Money of Virginia the receipt whereof the said Benjamin Williamson
doth acknowledge hath granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed
and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain alienfeoff
and confirm unto the said Arthur Williamson and to his heirs and
assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land and premises with
the appurtenances situate lying and being in the County of
Southampton containing three hundred and ten acres more or less
lying and being in on the S^t side of Secesh swamps and bounded as
followeth Beginning at a black oak in the said Benjamin Williamson
old line then the new survey so with eighty degrees east one hundred &
Eight pole to a red oak then south fifteen degrees with one hundred
and seventy seven pole to a white oak then south seventy five degrees
west one hundred and six pole to a white oak then south eighty degrees
west fifty seven pole to a red oak a corner tree in the aforesaid old line
from thence to a mulberry tree in Browns old field then to white oak
on edge of low grounds of the said swamps thence to the run and up
the various courses of the said swamp to a white oak from thence
