grants or mortgages and all other incumbrances whatsoever in the which
I do hereby transfer and oblige my self my heirs and assigns to warrant and
defend this my sale of all and singular the premises together with their
and every of their appurtenances unto him the s^d Arthur Williamson his
heirs and assigns forever against all & every other person or persons shall and
will warrant and forever defend by these presents In witness whereof the
