This Indenture made this twenty fourth day of May in the
 year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred & fifty nine
 between Henry Applewhite of the county of Southampton of the
 one part & Samuel Pate & Thomas Pate of the county of the
 other part Witnesseth that said Saml Pate & Tho Pate for and in
 Consideration of the sum of thirty two pounds eleven shillings
 current money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Henry
 Applewhite ^{but then have given a receipt for said sum and confirmed unto the said Henry Applewhite} his heirs and assigns forever all that certain tract or
 parcel of land situate lying & being in the said county of
 Southampton on the north side of the three Creeks containing by
 estimation one hundred & fifty acres be the same more or less & bounded
 as followeth (to wit) on the west by Edward Harris's line of marked trees on
 the south by great Ploughman's swamp from the east & north by the land
 of the said Applewhites and also all houses edifices buildings gardens
 Orchard lands trees woods ways waters and advantages whatsoever
 to the said tract or parcel of land belonging or in any wise appertaining
 also all the right title estate interest claim or demand whatsoever of
 them the said Samuel Pate & Tho Pate of in or to the same & the
 said land was bequeathed to the said Samuel Pate but not to his heirs
 by his Father Edward Pate as it is imagined it will after the said
 Pate's decease return to the said Tho Pate therefore the said Thomas
 Pate in presence of these witnesses to this indenture relinquishes
 all right title estate claim & demand he the said Thomas Pate

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
