 sum of thirty two pounds eleven shillings of like current money of
 Virginia with lawfull interest for the same from the date of these
 presents on or before the 2 day of January ^{that} shall be in the year of Lord Christ
 one thousand seven hundred & seventy & the cost that shall arise for
 recording these presents & that then & in such cases these presents and
 every thing herein mentioned shall cease determine & be void any thing
 herein contained to the contrary notwithstanding In witness whereof
