and sold and by these presents do fully clearly and absolutely give grant
bargain sell & confirm unto the said Elizabeth Gray one Negro Boy
called and known by the name of Will To have and to hold the said Negro
to the aforesaid Elizabeth Gray her heirs executors and assigns to her
and their proper use and behoof forever thereof and thereof with advise and
dispose at her and their will and pleasure as of her their proper place
without any manner of challenge claim or demand of me the said John Gray
or any other person or persons from me in my name by my cause means
consent or procurement and further know ye that the said John Gray
have put the said Elizabeth Gray in free possession of the said Negro by the
Delivery unto her at the inscaling hereof In witness whereof I the said
