This indenture made this twenty seventh day of December in the ninth year
of the reign of our sovereign lord George the third now king of Great Britain
France and Ireland &c and in the year of our lord Christ one thousand seven
hundred and sixty eight Between Samuel Holden of the county of Johnson in
the province of North Carolina and Martha his wife of the one part & George
Branch of the parish of Nottoway in the county of Southampton colony
of Virginia of the other part Witnesseth that the said Samuel Holden
and Martha his wife for and in consideration of the sum of thirty five
pounds current money of Virginia to him in hand paid the receipt
whereof the said Samuel Holden doth hereby acknowledge and thereof
quit and discharge the said George Branch his heirs executors and
administrators by these presents Have and each of them Hath granted
bargained sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents Do
and each of them Doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff and confirm
unto the said George Branch and to his heirs and assigns forever or all
that plantation tract or parcel of land lying and being in the afore-
said parish of Nottoway and county of Southampton on the North side of
Round Hill swamp and bounded as followeth to wit Beginning at a notable
by the side of the said swamp thence south sixty degrees east one hundred
and six pole to a red oak then east north east sixty four poles to a line
thence north thirty degrees east one hundred and three poles
