& sold aliened conveyed & confirmed & by these presents doth grant bargain
sell alien confirm unto the said John Smith his heirs &
assigns for ever a certain tract or parcel of land containing one hundred
& thirty acres be the same more or less situate lying & being on the north
side of the said swamp in the County of Southampton ofered & bound
by the most known & reputed bounds it being the land & plantation then
on the said Benjamin Halliman now dwelling & also all trees woods
underwoods commons common of pastures profits commodities ad-
vantages emolument & hereditaments whatsoever to the said tract or parcel
of land above mentioned belonging or in anywise appertaining & in or
upon the same growing happening or arising and also the reversions
& reversion remainder & remainders rents & services of the said
premises of every part thereof & also all the estate right title interest
claim & demand whatsoever of them the said William & Benjamin
Halliman of in & to the said premises & every part thereof To have &
hold all and singular the said premises & every part & parcel thereof
with the appurtenances unto the said John Smith his heirs & assigns
for ever & the said William & Benjamin Halliman for them & their heirs
the said tract of land & every part thereof against them & their heirs
& against all & every other person & persons whatsoever the said John Smith
his heirs & assigns shall & well warrant & for ever defend by them
