

intended marriage shall take effect & in consideration of such marriage
 the said Albrighton Jones for himself his heirs executors & administrators
 agree that all such estate as the said Mary shall be possessed of at the
 time of her marriage with him of what nature or kind soever & all sums
 of money slaves goods or other effects which may be given unto her or descend
 by or from the death of any ^{person} shall stand remain & be her sole pro-
 perty & it is further agreed between the parties that the said Albrighton
 his heirs executors & administrators are hereby declared to stand & remain & be
 trustee to & for the said Mary to secure for her all her lands tenements
 & chattels rents & profits during the term of her intermarriage with
 the said Albrighton Jones for himself his heirs executors & administrators doth
 promise & it is the true intent & meaning of these presents & if the intended
 marriage shall take effect & the said Albrighton Jones shall depart this
 life leaving her the said Mary his widow that then & in that case the
 heirs executors & administrators of the said Albrighton shall after the expiration
 of twelve months pay & satisfy unto the said Mary her heirs executors & administrators
 or assign the sum of one hundred pounds current money of Virginia
 which the said Mary Lemmon doth hereby agree to take in lieu & full
 satisfaction of all dower she might otherwise claim by law or might
 be intitled ^{where necessary} unto of her lands slaves or personal estate from the heirs executors
 administrators of the said Albrighton Jones who she on the receipt of the
 sum aforesaid is to discharge & doth hereby acknowledge herself to be there
 with fully satisfied & it is further agreed between the said Albrighton
 & the said Mary that the said Albrighton Jones shall have full power
 & authority to sell & dispose of as much of the said Mary's estate or other
 thing of her property as will be sufficient to satisfy & pay her the said
 Mary debt as is or shall be due at the time of her intermarriage with
 the said Albrighton Jones to any person or persons whatsoever & it is
 further agreed between the said Albrighton & the said Mary that all
 & every other part of the said Mary's estate Real lands rents goods or
 chattels or slaves except two small negro girls called & known by the
 names of Pulday & Wanny which the said Albrighton doth agree that
 in case the said Marriage shall take effect that the said Mary shall
 have a full right & power at any time she shall think fit to give or dispose
 of them the said negro girls to her children or any other person whatsoever
 as she shall think proper & it is further agreed between the said Albrighton
