This Indenture made this twelfth day of December in the year of
 the said Thomas Chappell of Southampton county of the one part & Mary Chappell of the same county of
 the other part witnesseth that the said Thomas Chappell for consideration
 of the fine love that he hath for his daughter Mary Chappell both hereby
 acknowledges that he hath given & delivered to his said daughter Mary Chappell
 & to her heirs for ever one negro girl called Judah & by these presents doth
 acknowledge that he the said Thomas Chappell hath given & delivered the same
 girl called Judah unto the said Mary Chappell & to her heirs for ever to
 have & hold the said negro girl called Judah to the only proper use & behoof of
 the said Mary Chappell & to her heirs & assigns for ever & the said Thomas Chappell
 doth for himself & his heirs & assigns further agree with the said Mary Chappell & her heirs
 that the said Thomas Chappell shall & will warrant & defend the right
 title & the above negro girl called Judah unto the said Mary Chappell
