This Indenture made this sixth day of March 1770 in the ninth year of the  
 reign of our sovereign Lord George the third now King of Great Britain &c. in the  
 Year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred & seventy between Robert  
 Carr & Mary his wife of the parish of Newport & county of Isle of Wight of the one  
 part & John Blith of the county of Southampton of the other part witnesseth  
 that the said Robert Carr & Mary his wife for &c. consideration of the sum of three  
 pounds current money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said John Blith  
 the receipt whereof the said Robert Carr & Mary his wife doth hereby acknowledge  
 & thereof acquit & discharge the said John Blith his heirs &c. & assigns by then  
 present hath granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed & confirmed & by then  
 present doth bargain grant sell alien enfeoff & confirm unto the said John Blith  
 & to his heirs & assigns for ever all that tract or parcel of land lying & being in the  
 aforesaid parish & county of Southampton containing by estimation one hundred  
 acres be the same more or less & bounded as followeth to wit Beginning  
 at a red Oak a Corner Tree of William Edwards thence down a North  
 course to a branch thence down the said Branch to one prong of the Great
