Shall hundred seventy Between Edmund Day of the county of Southampton of the one part & Samson
 Revell of the aforesaid county of the other part Witnesseth that the said Edmund Day
 in consideration of the sum of ten pounds current money of Virginia to him
 in hand paid at or before the enrolling & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof
 he the said Edmund Day doth hereby acknowledge hath given granted bargain
 sold & confirmed & by these presents doth grant bargain sell & confirm unto the
 said Samson Revell one certain tract or parcel of land situate lying & being in
 the county of Southampton aforesaid Beginning at a white oak John Popes cor-
 ner then along a path to a lightwood stake a corner of Howell Camunds then
 along the said Howell Camunds line to a Maple in the Meadon branch Bri-
 dges Popes corner then along the said Popes line to the road then along the
 road to the Beginning Containing by estimation fifty acres to the same more
 or less & also the reversion & reversions remainder & remainders of the above land &
 premises & also all the estate right title interest property claim & demand
 whatsoever of him the said Edmund Day in or to the above mentioned tract
 of land To have & to hold the said demised land & premises with the
 appurtenances unto the said Samson Revell his heirs & assigns for ever & the said
 Edmund Day doth for himself his heirs executors & administrators warrant & defend
 the said land & premises from the lawfull claims & demands of any person or
 persons whatsoever unto him the said Samson Revell his heirs & assigns
 for ever to the only proper use & behoof of him the said Samson Revell his heirs
 & assigns for ever & the said Edmund Day doth further covenant & agree that at any
 time or times hereafter at the reasonable request of him the said Samson Revell
 his heirs or assigns shall & will make such other & further conveyance in the law
 for the better confirming & securing making the said premises In witness whereof the said
