This Indenture made this 14th day of March in the year of our lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and seventy Between Harris Taylor of the County of Southampton in the Province of Virginia Ephraim Williams of the County of Providence aforesaid witnesseth that the said Harris Taylor for and in consideration of the sum of twenty five pounds current money of Virginia to the said Harris in hand paid by the said Ephraim Williams at & before the enrolling & delivery of this present the receipt whereof the said Harris Taylor doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed & confirmed & by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff & confirm unto the said Ephraim Williams & his heirs & assigns for ever a tract or parcel of land with the appurtenances situate lying & being in the said county of Southampton containing one hundred acres more or less & Bounded as followeth Beginning at a pine by the side of the Little Swamp a Corner of Oliver Woodards land then by the said Woodards line North thirty five degrees east eighty five poles to a pine & east eighty seven poles to a small pine a corner of Robert Bryants land thence by the said Bryants line & North thirty five degrees east nineteen poles to a pine then
