This Indenture made this twelfth day of April in the tenth Year of the reign of our
 Sovereign Lord George the third now King of Great Britain &c. in the year of our Lord Christ
 one thousand seven hundred and seventy Between Moses Johnson & Mary Johnson his
 wife of the parish of Nottoway and county of Southampton of the one part & John Johnson
 of the said parish & county of the other part witnesseth that the said Moses & Mary Johnson
 for and in consideration of the sum of thirty pounds lawful money of Virginia to them in
 hand paid by the said John Johnson the receipt whereof the said Moses & Mary Johnson do
 hereby acknowledge and thereto acquit and discharge the said John Johnson his heirs and
 assigns by these presents hath granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed & confirmed by these
 presents doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff & confirm unto the said John Johnson his
 heirs and assigns for ever all that tract or parcel of land situated lying & being
 in the aforesaid parish of Nottoway & county of Southampton containing by estimation
 one hundred acres be the same more or less & bounded as followeth to wit) beginning
 at a white oak a corner tree between Thomas Jones & Wm Jones running a line of marked
 trees to a hickory another corner tree between Thos Jones & Arthur Smith & thence along
 a line of marked trees to Seacock swamp & thence up the said swamp to a persimmon
 tree another corner tree & so up a Branch to a pine another corner tree & so a new line
 of marked trees to the beginning together with all houses out houses edifices buildings
 yards gardens orchards trees ways waters watercourses profits commodities here-
 appurtenances unto the said ^{plantation} tract or parcel of land belonging or anywise
 appertaining of the reversion & reversions remainders & remainders contingent & profits
 thereof every part & parcel thereof & all the estate right title interest & property claim
 & demand whatsoever of them the said Moses & Mary Johnson of in or to the same or any
 part or parcel & all the deeds evidences & writings touching or anywise concerning
 the same To have and to hold the said plantation tract or parcel of land and
 premises with the appurtenances unto the said John Johnson his heirs and
 assigns to the only use and behoof of him the said John Johnson his heirs & assigns
 and the said Moses & Mary Johnson for themselves their heirs executors
 administrators doth covenant promise & grant to & with the said John Johnson
 his heirs executors & administrators by these presents that the said Moses & Mary
 Johnson do give all the aforesaid premises with the appurtenances unto the said
 John Johnson his heirs and assigns against all & every person or persons
