This Indenture made this twelfth day of October one thousand seven hundred & eighty nine
Between John Taylor of the parish of St. Luke in the county of Southampton of the one part
and Anthony Evans of the parish of Wottonway County of Southampton of the other part
Witnesseth that the said John Taylor for & in consideration of the sum of one hundred & five
pounds thirteen shillings & four pence current money of Virginia to him in hand paid
at & upon the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt of which he himself
satisfied contented & paid doth hereby acknowledge that he hath granted bargained & sold
aliened & confirmed by these presents doth give grant bargain sell alien & confirm
unto the said Anthony Evans his heirs and assigns for ever part of that parcel of land
of land lying & being in the above said parish of Wottonway County of said colony
by estimation three hundred & twenty acres more or less bounded as follows to wit
beginning at a small pine on the south side of a small branch of the Deep Branch alone
true in the outside line of Wottonway Indians land thence by the S. Indians to
line south east forty eight pole to three new chopt inwards then south
east by south seventy two pole to a pine thence south fifty degrees west one
