 this certain Indenture bearing date the second day of march one thousand seven hundred
 & seventy have sold & conveyed to Thomas Carrell of the County of Southampton the several
 estate of &c in one certain tract or parcel of land containing three hundred acres lying
 & being in the said county of Southampton And whereas the said Christian cannot
 conveniently travel to the court of our said county of Southampton to make
 acknowledgement of the said conveyance Therefore We do give unto You
 Josiah Kiddick Willis Kiddick & Samuel Botoon gent or any two of You
 power to receive the acknowledgement which the said Christian shall
 be willing to make before You of the conveyance aforesaid contains in the
 said indenture which is hereto annexed & We do therefore command you that you
 or any two of You do personally go to the said Christian & examine her privately and
 apart from the said Gardenier Fleming her husband whether she doth & does
 freely & voluntarily without the persuasion or threats of her said husband &
 whether she be willing that the same shall be recorded in the court of our said
 county of Southampton & when you have received her acknowledgement & examined
 her as aforesaid that you distinctly & plainly certify whether of under your
 seals sending thither then the said indenture & this writ with the said Richard Kiddick
 clerk of our said Court at the Courthouse the twelfth day of march in the sixth
 Year of our reign.
