This Indenture made this thirteenth day of July one thousand seven hundred & seventy Between Wm Glover of the County of Southampton of the one part & John Lawrence of the County of Suffolk of the other Part Witnesseth that the said William & Patience Glover for and in consideration of the sum of sixty five Pounds current Money of Virginia then in hand paid by the said John Lawrence the receipt whereof the said William & Patience Glover doth hereby acknowledge & thereof acquit & discharge the said John Lawrence his heirs Executors & administrators by these presents hath bargain'd granted sold Alien enfeoffed & confirm'd & by these presents doth bargain grant sell Alien enfeoff & confirm unto the said John Lawrence & his heirs & assigns forever all that tract or parcel of Land lying & being in the County of Southampton containing by Estimation one hundred Acres be the same more less & bounded as followeth to wit Beginning at the mouth of the river Parich thence up the warden's Course of the said Branch to white oak thence west through the pearson's branch to the corner Tree of William Glover thence south two degrees west to Cypress swamp thence down the said swamp to the Beginning Together with all houses outhouses edifices building & arable grounds orchards trees water wheels Courses profits & commodities hereditaments & appurtenances to the said tract or parcel of Land belonging or in any way appertaining to the same
