 paid by the said Joseph Munsford The receipt whereof the said W^m Glover
 doth hereby acknowledge he the said W^m Glover hath Granted bargained
 & sold Alien'd & Confirmed & by these presents grant Bargain and sell
 Alien & Confirm unto the said Joseph Munsford his heirs & assigns
 forever A Certain Tract or parcel of Land lying in the County of Hamp-
 ton on the South Side of the Cypress Swamp Near black water river
 beginning at the ^{main} road on the swamp & running west to the head line then
 East 100 feet to a Corner Tree then North to a red oak then East
 to a live oak then North to the Mouth of Jack Branch then up the ^{Swamp}
 to the Beginning the same being part of a Tract of Land Purchased of the
 Executors of W^m Haynes Deceased by deed bearing date in Month of Sept
 & also all Lanes Trees Woods Under woods & other Commons Common
 of Pastures Profits Commodities Advantages hereunto in ways water
 & appurtenances whosoever to the said Messuages or Tenements & premises
 above mentioned belonging or any wise appertaining & also the revenues
