of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and seventy between James
Birchett of the County of Southampton of the one part & John Rogers
of the s^d County of the other part Witnesseth that the s^d James Birchett
natural Love & affection which hath and beareth unto the s^d John
Rogers but more especially for and in consideration of the sum
of five shillings current money of Virginia unto the said James
Birchett by the said John Rogers in hand paid at or before the
sealing of these presents the receipt whereof of every part thereof the s^d
James Birchett doth acknowledge himself fully satisfied hath
granted bargained sold made over & confirmed unto the s^d John
Rogers his heirs & assigns forever three Negroe Slaves to wit. Lucy
Mungo & Clary to have & to hold the s^d Negroes unto the s^d John
Rogers his heirs & assigns forever & the said James Birchett for him
self his heirs Executors & Administrators doth covenant agree to & with
the said John Rogers his heirs and assigns that the said James
Birchett the said negroes slaves against him & his heirs & against all &
every other person or persons shall & will well warrant & forever
