 more or less the said dividend of land being part of a patent
 Senior bearing date the 17th of September 1738 & bounded as follows
 beginning a hickory a corner Tree of the said Robt Williams line then by
 Line of marked trees to a Maple in a branch up the said branch to
 in John Johnsons S. line thence by the said John Johnsons line to a pine then
 down the said Robert Williams line to the beginning with last purchase
 profitable common & other advantages & emoluments heretofore enjoyed
 to the said land belonging or in anywise appertaining or upon the same
 growing happening or arising & also the Reversion & Reversions therein
 of Remainders rents services of the premises Every part thereof & also all the
 Estate Right title Int claim & demand whatsoever of him the said
 Williams of or to the same premises Every part thereof To have & to hold
 all & singular the said premises above mentioned & every part thereof
 the appurtenances unto the said Robert Williams his heirs or assigns to the
 only proper use & behoof of the said Robt Williams his heirs & assigns forever
 and the said Robt Williams & his heirs the said land & premises Every part
 thereof against him & his heirs & against all & every other person
 whatsoever unto the said Robert Williams his heirs & assigns
