with a flit in the right ear of a halp moon under the left year also one set
of black Smiths tools viz: One Anvil & Bellows two Dies & all other
Smiths Tools contained in Simons shop To have & to hold this
battel & Tools forever & I the s: Jacob Simons my heirs & assigns
& defend the title of thes: battel & Tools to the s: Edmund Day his
heirs & assigns against all manner of Persons or Persons whatsoever
