The Bradsheaw of the parish of Wollaway in the County of Southampton of the one part & George Summrell of the vth parish & County of the other part Whereas the vth The Bradsheaw doth Justly Indebted to the vth George Summrell in the sum of £15^{..} 5^{..} 6 Where this Indenture therefore Witnesseth that as well for Securing the payment of this sum with that from the date hereof as also for & in consideration of the sum of five Shillings to him the vth Thomas Bradsheaw in hand prd at or before sealing of this hereof the receipt hereof he doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargain and sold alien & conveyed & confirmed by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien & confirm unto the vth George Summrell his heirs & assigns forever the plantation and Tract or parcel of Land whereon now lies situate lying & being in the aforesaid parish of Wollaway & County of Southampton on the North side of Black Creek Swamp containing by Estimation 60 acres & the same more or less & bounded according to the most known ancient and reputed bounds thereof and all houses out houses edifices buildings yards gardens Orchards Trees ways & waters & Water courses profits & Commodities hereditaments & appurtenances whatsoever to the vth tract or parcel of Land belonging or in anywise appurtenant and the Reversion & Reversions Remainder & Remainders Rent issues and profits thereof and all the estate right title & Int^y property claim & demand of him the vth The Bradsheaw of & to the same every part thereof to have & to hold the vth 60 acres of Land & appurtenances to the vth George Summrell his heirs & assigns to the only proper use & behoof of him the vth George Summrell his heirs & assigns forever & the vth The Bradsheaw for himself his heirs & assigns forever Covenant to Grant the vth George Summrell
