 current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said John Lawrence the
 whereof the said John Lawrence doth hereby acknowledge he the said John Lawrence
 hath granted Bargained sold aliened & confirmed by these presents doth give
 sell alien & confirm unto the said John Lawrence his heirs & assigns forever all and
 that or parcel of Land situate lying & being in the County of Southampton upon
 the south side of the main Black Water it being part of a pattern granted to the said
 the 16 day of 17th bounded as followeth Beginning at a pine wood & a small
 line on the side of the Cattail Branch & along the said small line to a white
 oak by the Little Poccon side so along the said Line Red oak Corner tree of the said
 thence along the said Lawrence line to the Mowry Branch so up the Run
 of the said Branch to the first station it being of estimation & in the County of Southampton
