This Indenture made this 9 day of Jan^y in the year four
thousand seven hundred and seventy two between George Gurley
Sen^r of the County of Southampton & Colony of Virginia of the one part
and William Britt of North Carolina & County of Hertford of the other
part Witnesseth that the said George Gurley Sen^r and Mary his wife
for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and thirty pounds cur-
rency of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said William Britt the receipt
he doth hereby acknowledge of the s^d sum of 130 and thereof and therefrom
doth acquit & discharge the said William Britt his heirs & assigns and assigns
by their presents hath given granted sold aliened conveyed and confirmed
and by their presents doth fully sell and absolutely give granted bargain sell
alien convey and confirm unto the said William Britt his heirs and assigns
two certain tracts or parcels of lands lying situate in the County of Southampton
in Virginia on the South side of Nolloway river one which is the whole of the
Patent granted to Edward Shelly bearing date the first day of the first 1763 contain-
ing 203 acres whose bounds and limits may be known as expressed in the s^d Patent referred
thence to be had being the other by estimation containing 315 acres lying adjacent
