 always & It is the true intent & meaning of these presents That if the s^d George
 Sumnerrell my heirs Executors & assigns shall & do well and truly pay or cause to
 be paid unto the s^d Newsom Branch his Executors & assigns the full sum
 of Sixty Pounds with Interest thereon from the day of the date hereof the 8 day
 of October 1771 without any deduction or abatement whatsoever then this present
 Bill of Sale to be void & of no effect or else to remain in full force & virtue until
 default shall be made in payment of the s^d principal money and Interest
 contrary to the proviso above mentioned that then it shall & may be
 lawfull to and for the said Newsom Branch his Executors & assigns
 at any time after the eight day of October afores^d to sell & dispose of all or
 such part of the said goods and Chattels as he the s^d Newsom Branch
 his Executors administrators or assigns shall think fitt at such price
 or prices as may be Reasonably had obtained for the same & thereout in
 the first place to pay deduct or retain to him or themselves the s^d principal
 money and Interest with the charges arising by such sale or disposal & the
 surplus of such money if any be together with the Remainder of the goods &
 Chattels if any so shall happen to be unsold or undisposed of shall be
 hereby agreed to be rendered or delivered to me the s^d George Sumnerrell
 my heirs Executors & assigns And it is lastly agreed by this parties
 that until default shall be made in proviso herein before mentioned
 the s^d George Sumnerrell shall continue in possession of the s^d goods and
 Chattels In Witness whereof the s^d George Sumnerrell hath hereunto
 set his hand & Seal this 8 day of October 1771
