This Indenture made this 9 day of April in the year of our Lord one
 thousand seven hundred & seventy two Between Henry Pope & Ann his wife
 of the parish of Mottoway & County of Southampton of the one part & Rich^d
 Mott of the same parish & County of the other part Witnesseth that the said
 Henry Pope and Ann his wife for and in consideration of the sum of thirty
 pounds ten Shillings current money of Virginia to them in hand paid
 by the said Richard Mott the receipt whereof they doth hereby acknow-
 ledge hath granted & bargained sold aliened released and confirmed &
 by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien released & confirmed unto
 the said Richard Mott & his heirs & assigns one certain tract or parcel
 of Land & premises with the appurtenances thereto belonging lying &
 being in the aforesaid parish of Mottoway & County of Southampton
 containing by estimation 6 Acres be the same more or less & bounded as
 follows beginning at a Maple standing in Gravelly Run then a line
 dividing this from the aforesaid Henry Pope's land & oak standing
 in William Joyner's line along the said Joyner's line to a scrubby white
 oak standing in a Wooded & from thence to Gravelly Run down
 the course of the said Run to the first station the same being part of a
 tract of Land which was purchased by one Rich^d Pope of Barnaby
 Wekinne and hath since come into the hands of Henry Pope with
 all houses outhouses edificies buildings yards gardens turnways
 watercourses profits commodities hereditaments & appurtenances
 to the said tract or parcel of Land belonging or in anywise appertaining
