and discharge the said Wm Mountfort his Executors Administrators and assigns forever
Both granted bargained sold aliened released & confirmed by their presents
Doth grant bargain sell alien release and confirm unto the said Wm Mountfort
his heirs and assigns forever all that manor tract & parcel of land whereon he
now lawfully sits lying being in the County of Southampton & Parish of Nottoway
containing by estimation two hundred acres be the same more or less & bounded as follows
