James Barden for and in consideration of the sum of seven pounds eight shilling
current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Edmund Crumpler at or
before the unsealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said James
Barden doth hereby acknowledge and himself therewith to be fully satisfied and
paid and thereof doth clearly acquit and discharge the said Edmund Crumpler
his heirs Executors and administrators forever by these presents hath given granted
bargained sold conveyed and confirmed and by these presents doth give grant
bargain sell convey and confirm unto the said Edmund Crumpler his heirs
and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land containing by estimation
twenty five Acres be the same more or less lying and being in the County aforesaid
and followeth Viz. Beginning at a pine at a Larchen branch so a line
of marked trees to sweet gum standing in the line branch so up the said branch
to a pine a corner tree thence a line of marked trees to pine standing in Tarryport
