This Indenture made this Sixteenth day of July. In the year
of our Lord Christ one thousand seven Hundred and seventy two
Between Gray Briggs of the County of Dinwiddie of the one part and
Thomas Wills of the County of Southampton of the other part
Whereas a certain Thomas Gray late of the County of Southampton
was in his life time at the time of his death was seized in his domains
as of fee of and in one certain tract of Land being the same whereon
said Thomas formerly lived, situation lying and being in the aforesaid County
of Southampton containing by estimation Nine Hundred and sixty
acres be the same more or less and bounded by the known antient

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
