This Indenture made this tenth day of September in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and seventy two between Thomas Wills and Elizabeth his wife of the parish of Netorway and county of Southampton of the one part and Jordan Denson of the parish and county of aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Thomas Wills and Elizabeth his wife for and in consideration of the just and full sum of Ninety pounds and one shilling current money of Virginia by the said Jordan Denson to them in hand bona fide paid at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Thomas Wills and Elizabeth his wife doth hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit discharge forever by these presents they the said Thomas Wills and Elizabeth his wife have granted bargained sold aliened conveyed released and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien convey release and confirm unto the said Jordan Denson his heirs and assigns forever all that messuage tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the aforesaid ~~parish~~ parish of Netorway and county of Southampton on Netorway swamp now in the possession and seisin of said Thomas Wills and being part of the lands of which said Thomas Wills bought of Gray Briggs as by Indenture bearing date the sixteenth day of July one Thousand seven hundred and seventy two and recorded in the County court of Southampton the thirteenth day of August one thousand seven hundred and seventy two relating being thereto had may more fully and at large appear containing by estimation three hundred and seventy acres be the same more or less And bounded as follows. To wit beginning in Nicholas Williams' and said Thomas Wills' line on Netorway swamp thence down the various courses of the run of the said swamp to the mouth of the Cabin branch thence up the various courses of the run of the said branch to Lewis Joiners line thence the said Joiners line to the aforesaid Nicholas Williams' line and thence by Williams' line to the first station and all houses outhouses Edifices buildings Yards Gardens orchards trees woods ways waters and water courses profits commodities hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said messuage tract or parcel of land of Three hundred and seventy acres) more or less belonging or in anywise appertaining and
