This Indenture made this twenty second day of August in the year of our Lord one Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy two between Henry Harris and Mary his Wife of the one part and Nathaniel Harris of the other part Witnesseth that the said Henry Harris and Mary his wife for in Consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds current money to them in hand paid by the said Nathaniel Harris the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted Bargained sold aliened Released and Confirmed and by these Presents do Grant Bargain sell alien enfeoff Released and Confirm and unto the said Nathaniel Harris his heirs and assigns forever one Certain tract or parcel of Land Situate lying and being in the Parish of St. Luke and County of ~~Virginia~~ Southampton in Virginia on the South side of the Flat swamp beginning at a gum Standing in the flat Swamp thence Running by a line of marked Trees south twenty five Degrees West one hundred and forty four poles to a Corner white oak thence south forty Degrees east hundred and seventy two pole to a hickory south seventy Degrees east hundred seventy poles to a Red oak Standings in the head of a Branch thence Down the said Branch various Courses of the stream to the flat swamp thence up the side Flat swamp the Various Courses of the stream to the first mentioned Station all which contain two hundred and eighty Acres by Pattern granted to Henry Harris Reference be thereunto had may more fully appear on the Records & also the Reversion and Reversions Remainder and Remainders unto issues and services thereto.
