To all people to whom this present writing shall come I Benjamin
Hasty of Southampton County planter do know ye that the said
Benjamin Hasty for in consideration of the love and affection
that I Bear unto Tomkins Sandiford of Edgecomb County in
the province of North Carolina having given granted & by these
presents do fully clearly and absolutely give grant & confirm unto
the said Tomkins Sandiford one Negro Boy called Daniel for ever
To have & hold the said Negro Daniel to the aforesaid Tomkin
Sandiford and his heirs Lawfully Begotten of his body his Executors
Administrators & assigns to him and their own proper uses and
Authority & behoof forever thereof and therewith to use and Dispose
of at his and their will and pleasure as of his and their own
proper Negro, without any manner of Challenging Claim or Demand
of me the said Benjamin Hasty or of any other person or persons
for me, in my name by me cause means or procurement.
But never the less if the said Tomkin Sandiford shall
Die and leave no heir Lawfully Begotten of his Body that
the said Negro Boy Daniel aforesaid shall Return
to Hill Sandiford and Samuel Sandiford and be equally
Divided Between the said Hill & Samuel Sandiford and
their heirs &c and farther know ye that I the said Benjamin
Hasty have put the said Tomkin Sandiford in full
possession of all & singular the aforesaid Negro by the
Delivery unto him at the sealing these present writings
thereof of the aforesaid Negro Boy called Daniel, in witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixt my seals
This the fifth Day of October, 1772
