This Indenture made this twelfth day of June in the year  
four Lord one thousand seven hundred & seventy two, Between  
John Thorpe Esq<sup>r</sup> of John Thorpe Dec<sup>d</sup> of Southampton County  
& parish of St. Luke & Edward Harris Sen<sup>r</sup> of the said County  
& parish of Wittenburg. That the said John Thorpe Esq<sup>r</sup> of John  
aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty five  
pounds & one penny current money of Virginia to him in  
hand paid by the said Edward Harris to him in  
whereof is hereby acknowledged to the said John Thorpe Esq<sup>r</sup>  
aforesaid hath granted bargained & sold & doth by these presents  
grant bargain & sell by direction of his Father last present  
& Testament unto the said Edward Harris & to his heirs  
forever all that Tract or parcel of land lying & being in the parish  
& County aforesaid on the south side the three creeks containing  
Two hundred & twenty five Acres as by Patent granted to John  
Thorp Sen<sup>r</sup> bearing date the Fourteenth day of July in the year  
of our Lord One thousand Seven Hundred & sixty Nine & bounded as  
followeth (to wit) Beginning at a pine on the south side the  
three creeks a corner of John Thors land, thence by the said  
Jrby line South Two degrees west Twenty pole to a hickory  
South west by south Forty six pole to a black Oak, & West Twenty  
pole to a light wood post a corner of William Lees land thence by the  
said Lees line South fifteen Degrees west Ninety pole to a stake a  
corner of Edward Lunds land thence by the said Lees line South  
five Degrees west Ninety pole to a red Oak, South five Degrees  
west Seventy one pole to three Trees Chopt inwards, & South seventy five  
Degrees east fifty eight pole to a red Oak a corner of Amey Gullidges  
land thence by the said Gullidges line North Fifty degrees  
east Seventy eight pole to a red Oak a corner of David Adams land  
thence by the said Adams line North Fifty degrees east One  
hundred & eighteen pole to a black Oak a corner of William Mabrys  
land thence by Mabrys line North Seventy degrees west Seventy  
four pole to a red Oak, & North west one hundred & sixteen pole to a  
white Oak by the side of the three creeks aforesaid thence up the  
various Courses of the run of said creeks to the beginning And the  
Reversion & reversions remainder & remainders of all & singular  
the above granted premises & of every part & parcel thereof shall  
rent issues & profits to him or any part or parcel of them to him  
belonging or in any wise appertaining & also all the estate right  
Title interest Claim & demand whatsoever of him the said John  
Thorp Esq<sup>r</sup> of John Thorpe Dec<sup>d</sup> aforesaid of in & to the same or any  
part thereof, To have & to hold the above granted premises unto
