This Indenture made this 12th day of August in the Year of our Lord
Christ one Thousand seven hundred & seventy two Between William Pope of
Southampton County & parish of Nottoway of the one part & Henry Pope of the
County & parish aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said William
Pope for full consideration of the sum of eight pounds current money of Virginia
by the said Henry Pope to him in hand paid at or before the sealing & delivery
these presents the receipt whereof the said William Pope doth hereby acknowledge
of the receipt of acquit & discharge the said Henry Pope his heirs & assigns forever
himself & them with fully satisfied contented & paid he the said William Pope
hath Granted bargained sold alien released & confirmed by these presents
doth Grant bargain sell alien release and confirm unto the said Henry Pope
his heirs & assigns forever All that plantation meadow Tract or parcel of land
whereon the said William Pope now lives Situated lying & being in the aforesaid
County of Southampton & parish of Nottoway containing by estimation One hundred
Acres more or less & bounded as follows to wit beginning at a poplar on the northeast
side of Gravelly run thence North degrees east Sixty six pole to an Oak near
the Sympre swamp thence North thirty five degrees west two fifty four pole
to a white Oak then south forty degrees west Sixty six pole to a pine by the side
of Gravelly run down the various courses of the said branch to the first Station
And all houses out houses & edifices buildings woods ways water & water courses
profits commodities hereditaments & appurtenances whatsoever to the same
belonging or in any wise appertaining And thereupon & reversion
remainder & remainders & profits thereof & all the estate right
Title interest claim or demand of him the said William Pope of and to the same
every part thereof To have & to hold the said plantation meadow Tract
& parcel of land aforesaid unto him the said Henry Pope his heirs & assigns
forever to the only proper use & behoof of him the said Henry Pope his heirs

One hundred Acres of land & premises with the Appurtenances unto the said
