This Indenture made this twentyfifth day of November in the year of our Lord
One thousand seven hundred and sixty Nine Between Joseph Griffin & Elizabeth
Griffin widows of John Griffin Dec^d of the County of Southampton of the one part
& Harmon Harris of the same County of the other part Witnesseth that the said
Joseph Griffin & Elizabeth Griffin for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty
pounds Current Money to them in hand paid by the said Harmon Harris
the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge that they have granted bargained
and sold alien conveyed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain
sell alien and confirm unto the said Harmon Harris his heirs and assigns forever
One certain Tract or parcel of land containing One hundred and fifty Acres be
the same more or less Situate lying and being in the said County of Southampton
being the Remainder part of a pattern granted to John Griffin for three hundred
Acres and bearing date the thirtieth day of March One thousand seven hundred
and forty three. And bounded as Mentioned in the said pattern granted to
John Griffin the one part whereof the above named Harmon Harris was
possessed with in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred & sixty four
with all woods underwoods profits Advantages and Appurtenances
whatsoever to the said land belonging or in any wise Appertaining thereunto
and also the reversion & reversions remainder & remainders rents & Services of the
said premises and every part thereof & all the estate right title Interest use
property Inheritance Claim & demand whatsoever of him the said Joseph
Griffin & Elizabeth Griffin or their heirs of in or to the said premises or any
part thereof To have & to hold all & singular the premises above mentioned
every part & parcel thereof with the Appurtenances unto the said Harmon
Harris his heirs & assigns to the only proper use & behoof of him the said
Harmon Harris his heirs & assigns forever & the said Joseph & Elizabeth
Griffin doth for their parts their heirs & assigns the said land & premises
above mentioned every part thereof unto the said Harmon Harris & his
heirs & assigns & shall & will warrant & forever defend by these presents In
Witness whereof the said Joseph & Elizabeth Griffin hath hereunto put
their hand & affixed their seal the day & year above written
