heirs & assigns Covenant promise & grant to give with the said Simon Doykin
in his heirs & assigns by these presents a warrant & defend the title of the said
Slaves against the Claim or demand of any person or persons whatsoever in
Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this second
day of February One Thousand Seven Hundred & seventy three

Sovereign Lord George the third by the Grace of God of Great Britain
France and Ireland King defender of the faith &c. and in the year of our Lord Christ
One thousand Seven hundred & seventy three. Between Richard Drake of the
County of Southampton and Margt Drake his Mother of the One part & John
Tatum of the County of Sussex George of the Other part. Witnesseth that the said Richard
Drake for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred pounds current Money
of Virginia to him in hand paid before the sealing and delivery of these presents
by the said John Tatum the receipt whereof the said Richard Drake doth hereby
Acknowledge that the said Richard Drake and Margt Drake his Mother hath
granted bargained and sold Alien and Confirmed & by these presents Doth
grant bargain and sell Alien Enfeoff and Confirm unto the said John Tatum
his heirs and assigns forever all that certain Tract or parcel of land whereon
the said Richard Drake and Margt Drake his Mother now lives Situate
lying and being in the County of Southampton and on the north side of
