One Thousand Seven hundred & seventy three Anno Domini
The Condition of the above Obligation is such that whereas Job Johnston
deceased the late husband of the above bound Elizabeth, did in his last will
& Testament bearing date the Thirtieth day of January One Thousand
Seven hundred & seventy three amongst other things did leave to be sold to the
highest bidder by John Beal his Executor named One Certain Tract of land
given to the said Job by his Father Benjamin containing One hundred & fifty
Acres Call'd & known by the Name of the Round Meadow Survey in the County
of Southampton Now whereas the said Elizabeth hath her right of Dower
in the said lands as it hath yet never been Conveyed away nor being from
under Conveyance Cannot legally relinquish her said Dower therefore she hath
given the above Obligation as above against her Claim thereto Now if the
above bound Elizabeth do at this time or at all Times hereafter Doubt Claim
or Reserve all her Right title & Dower Interest in or to the said lands
as aforesaid & have Harmless to the above Name Simmons Jones from any
Husband that she may or shall inter marry with hereafter then the
above Obligation to be void otherwise to Remain in full force for every Part
