This Indenture made the 8th Day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand seven
hundred & seventy three Between Benjamin Faircloth of Southampton County of the one
part & Winney Drake of the said County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Benj.
Faircloth for & in Consideration of the sum of Twenty two Pounds Current Money of Virginia
to him in hand paid by the said Winney Drake the receipt whereof the said Benjamin
Faircloth doth hereby Acknowledge hath granted Bargained & sold Alien Released &
Confirmed by these presents Doth grant Bargain & sell alien in full & confirm unto the
said Winney Drake her Heirs & assigns forever a certain Tractor parcel of Land lying &
being in the County of Southampton aforesaid Containing by Estimation & by the
lot the same be more or less bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a white Oak stand
ing on the side of the Sweet house Swamp then down the said Swamp South thirty Degrees
East fifty two pole then South Sixty Degrees west Sixty pole along the said Swamp to the
Mouth of the Spring Branch then up the said Branch West thirty pole then South
