Lord One thousand seven hundred & seventy three Between Thomas  
Williamson of William Urguhart of the Parish of Notoway County of  
Southampton Colony of Virginia Merchants & Partners of Trustee of  
George Summerell of the said Parish County of Colony of the one part &  
William Urguhart of the said Parish County of Colony of the other part  
Whereas the said George Summerell being indebted to the said  
Williamson & Urguhart in the sum of Six hundred & seventy nine pounds  
sixteen shillings & eight pence did by Indenture bearing Date the  
twenty third day of January in the Year of our Lord One thousand seven  
hundred & seventy one grant Bargain sell unto the said Williamson &  
Urguhart amongst other things one certain Tract or parcel of land lying  
lying in the Parish & county aforesaid containing Two hundred Acres  
more or less whereon the said George Summerell then lived bounded &  
distinguished by the most ancient known & customary bounds thereof in  
trust for them the said Williamson & Urguhart to sell & dispose of the same  
& to apply the money arising from the sale thereof towards discharging  
the aforesaid Debt & Interest as by the said Deed of trust remaining filed
