by the said Nathan Bryant at or before the Enrolling and delivery of these Presents the
Receipt whereof the said Cordall Norflut and Mary his wife doth hereby Acknowledge
& they doth acquit the said Nathan Bryant his heirs Executors & assigns hath Granted
Bargained sold Sold Alind Enfeoff confirmed & made over by these Presents doth Grant
Bargain Sell Alind Enfeoff confirm and make over unto the said Nathan Bryant
his heirs and assigns forever one certain Parcel or Dividend of Land lying and being
on the North Side of Tarroravia Creek in Southampton County aforesaid containing
300 acres more or less as is certified in Patent bearing date 22 July 1726 C. 1773
