This Indenture made this 21 day of December in the thirteenth year of the reign of our sovereign Lord King George the third now King of Great Britain &c. and in the year of our Lord Christ 1773 Between Richard Kello Clerk of the County of Southampton of the one part & Samuel Kello of the same County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Richard Kello as well for and in consideration of the natural love and affection which the said Richard has and bears unto the said Samuel as for and in consideration of the sum of five Shillings to him in hand Paid by the said Samuel the receipt whereof the said Richard Kello doth hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit and discharge the said Samuel his heirs Executors and Admors by these presents hath granted bargained sold aliened conveyed and confirmed unto the said Samuel Kello & to his heirs and assigns forever all that plantation tract or parcel of land with the water Grist Mill thereto adjoining situate lying and being in the County aforesaid containing by Estimation about 700 acres both the same more or less part of a larger tract whereon the said Richard Kello now resides that is to say all the land on this South side of the main road from where the line crosses the said road near the old Schoolhouse along the road to the road called Browns Road and along Browns Road to where the said Richard Kello's line crosses the same near the Ready Branch Bridge and also one half of all his the said Richard Kello's stock of cattle hogs & sheep now being upon the said Plantation and all houses out houses edifices buildings yards Gardens orchards trees ways waters water courses profits Commodities
