This Indenture made this 6 day of Sept^r in the year of our Lord 1773 between
 Thomas Lawrence & Margaret his wife of the County of Southampton & Parish of
 Nettoway of the one part and Matthew Wills of the County & Parish aforesaid, of the other part
 Witnesseth that for & in consideration of the Just and full sum of three Pounds current money of
 Virginia by the s^d Matthew Wills to them in hand paid, at or before the Ensealing & delivery of these
 presents the receipt whereof the s^d Thomas Lawrence & Margaret his wife doth hereby acknowledge
 and thereof acquit and Discharge the said Matthew Wills his heir & assigns forever by these
 Presents they the s^d Thomas Lawrence & Margaret his wife hath granted, bargained, sold
 aliened released and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell deliver alien
 release and confirm unto the s^d Matthew Wills his heir & assigns forever a tract or parcel
 of land lying & being in the County of Southampton & Parish of Nettoway afores^d containing
 by Estimation Ten Acres more or less and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a right
 Post in the s^d Wills line at corner of Abraham Mitchell thence along the said
 Mitchell line to a Gum in the Buzzard Pond thence up the s^d Road along a line
 of marsh trees to a Gum in the s^d Wills line thence along the s^d Wills line to the
 Beginning being part of a Patent Granted to Edward Bowden bearing Date the 16
 day of Nov^r 1752 and all houses outhouses edificies buildings woods ways waters
 And water courses Profits Commodities hereditaments & appurtenances whatsoever
 to the same belonging or in any wise appertaining and the Reversion & Reversions
 Remainder & Remainders rents Issues & Profits thereof & all the Estate Right Int^r of
 them the Thomas Lawrence & Margaret his wife of in and to the same every
 Part thing To have and to hold the s^d plantation meadow tract & Parcel
 of Ten acres of Land & Premises with the appurtenances unto him the s^d Matthew Wills
 his heirs & assigns forever to the only Proper use and behoof of him the s^d Matthew Wills his
 heirs & assigns forever for the s^d Thomas Lawrence & Margaret his wife for themselves their
 heirs & assigns forever the s^d Plantation meadow tract and Parcel of 10 acres of
 land and Premises with all & every the appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise
 appertaining unto the said Matthew Wills his heir & assigns forever against them the said
 Thomas Lawrence & Margaret his wife & against their heir and assigns & against
 all other person or persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and forever defend
 by these Presents In Witness whereof the said Thomas Lawrence & Margaret his wife
 have hereunto set their hands & seals the Day and year above written
