This Indenture made this 10th day of May in the year of our Lord Christ One thousand Seven hundred and Seventy three Between Jethro Denson & Ann his wife of Mottoway Parish in the County of Southampton of the one part and Jeremiah Draper of Mansfield County of the part Witnesseth that the said Jethro Denson & Ann his wife for and in Consideration of the sum of £25 Current money of Virg^a to them in hand paid by the said Jeremiah Draper the receipt whereof they hereby acknowledge and themselves therewith fully Paid and satisfied have hereby given granted bargained & sold & doth by these presents fully freely & clearly & absolutely give grant bargain & sell in full conveyance and forever make over and Convey unto the said Jeremiah Draper to him his heirs & assigns forever one Certain Tenement tract or parcel of Land Situate lying & being in the Parish & County aforesaid bounded as followeth Viz^t Beginning at a Line a Corner Tree of Jethro Denson's Standing near the head of a branch called Barnes branch thence North down the various Courses of the Main run of the said Branch to a Swamp called Black Creek thence down with the Main run of the said Creek to the mouth of a Branch called Poplar branch thence South up the run of the said Branch to a Line a Corner of Thomas Draper's thence a West Course a long Drapers line to the first Station all which Land so bounded as aforesaid contains by Estimation 100 Acres be the same more or less with all the rights & profits of appurtenances thereon or therein with all houses orchards Gardens & large ground woodlands grounds underwoods waters watercourses Mines & Minerals of trees of all kinds To have and to hold all the above demised Land & Premises with all & every of its appurtenances unto him the said Jeremiah Draper his heirs & assigns forever and the said Jethro Denson & Ann his wife doth hereby by further Covenant grant & agree to and with the said Jeremiah Draper his heirs & assigns that at the time of sealing and delivering of these presents that they had within themselves for them Reserved their heirs & assigns of good
