This Indenture made this 11 day of Nov in the 16th year of the reign of our sovereign
 Lord George the third now King of Great Britain & And in the year of our Lord
 Christ 1773 Between Arthur Bowing of the parish of Nettoway & County of
 Southampton of the one part & Beny Griffin of the same parish & County of
 the other part Witnesseth that the s^d Arthur Bowing for & in consideration
 of the sum of thirty seven pounds ten shillings current money of Virginia
 to him in hand paid by the s^d Benjamin Griffin the receipt whereof he
 the s^d Arthur Bowing doth hereby acknowledge & there of acquit and
 discharge the s^d Benjamin Griffin his heirs & assigns that he granted
 bargained sold aliened enfeoffed & confirmed and by these presents doth
 grant bargain sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto the s^d Benjamin
 Griffin and to his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of
 land situate lying & being in the parish of Nettoway & County of Southampton
 apiece on the North side of Black Creek containing by Estimation 175 acres
 be the same more or less & bounded as followeth to wit beginning at a post or
 in the Cabin swamp then running to Thomas Bradshaw then to
