This Indenture made this 26 day of October 1773 between Anthony Evans of Mary's
wife of the parish of Mottoway and County of Southampton of the one part & Rich^d Blow of the
same parish & County of the other part Witnesseth that the ^{sa} Anthony Evans & wife
Mary for in consideration of the sum of one hundred & sixty pounds current money of
Virg^a to them in hand paid at or before the sealing and delivering of these presents
the receipt of which and themselves fully satisfied contented & paid they the ^{sa} Anthony
Evans and Mary his wife doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargain sold
Alien'd & confirmed & by these presents doth Give grant bargain sell Alien'd & confirm unto
the ^{sa} Rich^d Blow his heirs & assigns forever all that tract or parcel of Land whereon
they the ^{sa} Anthony Evans & Mary his wife now liveth lying & being on the North side
of the Apumocac Swamp in the parish and County afores^d & containing by estimation
325 acres more or less bounded as followeth (to wit) beginning at a pine on the south
side of a small branch of the deep branch a line tree in the out side line of the Mottoway
Indians Land thence by the ^{sa} Indians old line South East W⁸ by pole to the true
