This Indenture made the 5th day of January in the year of our Lord 1774 Between
Francis Nowel & Mary Nowel his wife of Brunswick county of the one Part & Ann Gray of
Southampton county of the other part Witnesseth that the said Francis Nowel & Mary his
wife for and in consideration of the sum of thirty pounds current money of Virg^a to him in
hand paid by the said Ann Gray the receipt whereof the s^r Francis Nowel & Mary his wife
Doth hereby acknowledge have granted bargained & sold aliened & confirmed & by these
presents do grant bargain sell alien & confirm unto the s^r Ann Gray her heirs & assigns
forever one certain tract or parcel of land containing One hundred & thirty acres be the
same more or less lying & being in Southampton County & of the parish of Stukes on the North
side of Meherrin River and bounded as followeth Beginning at a Red oak on
John McClellan's line thence South by the Johnston line to a red oak a corner thence
North by Thomas Turners line to a white oak a corner thence of Henry Harris line thence
East to a red oak a corner of John Morgans line thence by John Grays line & John Lays line
