divers other good causes & consideration me hereunto moving have given & granted and
by these presents do fully clearly and absolutely give grant and confirm unto the said
Benjamin Faircloth Sen^r all & singular that part of the Tract of Land by me now
possest in said county by Virtue of his Majesty's Patent being situate & bounded in manner
and form as followeth to wit Beginning at a corner Gum Tree between Brittain
Dope and my Line on Sweathouse Swamp then along s^d line to a corner Pine tree
then along a line of marked trees to a corner pine tree then along a line of marked trees
to a corner Pine tree standing on the head of the Spring Branch then down the Spring
Branch to the Sweathouse Swamp then down s^d Swamp to the Beginning to
gather with all its appurtenances belonging containing by Estimation Sixty five acres to the
said Benjamin Faircloth Sen^r his heirs Executors administrators and assigns to his & their own
proper use and behoof forever thereupon & therewith to do use & Dispose at his & their Will & pleasure
as his or their own proper Estate without any manner of Challenge claim or demand of me
the s^d Benjamin Faircloth Sen^r or my heirs or adm^r or of any other Person or Persons
for me in any Name or by my Cause or consent having put him the s^d Ben^y Faircloth
Sen^r in full Possession of the above mentioned premises before the signing of these presents
and for the full Intent and Performance I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal
